

Pickering Indoor Soccer Rules Matrix For Recreational/House league & Street Soccer

- No Coin Toss, The team facing the clock will kick-off first
- Kick-offs can go in any direction (forward or backwards) for Pickering Recreational/Houseleague
- Kick-offs for Street Soccer (Saturday am) may on move forward or along the halfway line.
- Game sheets for Recreational soccer (Sunday am, must be picked up in front lobby prior to game. Have the coaches sign them as well as you (the referee) at the completion of the game and place them in the lobby mailbox.
- Game sheets for Street soccer can be picked up in the Lobby Mail Box
- Caution forms, Sending off forms & Special Incident forms are in the mailbox slot in the main lobby.
- Complete game score on Referee Savvy for Recreation league-Not Required for Street Soccer
- **For Street Soccer**, If anybody receives a card, you must get the players name and colour of jersey or Country-Jerseys have no numbers
- **For Street Soccer**-obtain from each coach the game sheet. Have each coach sign it at the end of the game, complete it (fill in the scores), sign it and place it in the mail box for street soccer. All penalties must be served for the entire amount of time (The player must serve the whole 2 or 5 minute penalty despite if the attacking team scores with the man advantage or not).
- Penalty Kicks will be 10 yards away from the goal line. All players except for the Keeper and the person taking the penalty kick must be at least 2 yards behind the ball.
- All Restarts are indirect except for the penalty kick
- **The retreat line will be approximately 5 yards inside the halfway line.**
- **What would happen is as follows:**

• **When the goalkeeper has the ball at a goal kick or after making a save, the opposing team members would 'retreat' to the halfway line. Once all opposing players have retreated to the line, the goalkeeper can successfully throw or pass the ball to one of his/her teammates. The goalkeeper can also choose to dribble the ball or play quickly to a teammate before the retreat has taken place by opposing players.**

PLAYERS SAFETY

- Players should not wear anything that endangers themselves or any other players
- basic equipment consists of shirt, shorts, socks, shin guards and appropriate footwear
- jewelry is not permitted and cannot be taped over
- Sports hijabs/head scarves are permitted
- Medic alert bracelets and necklaces are permitted but must be fastened securely
- A drop ball will be awarded if there is an injury or interference from an outside agent
- After a goal is scored, all players must be in their own half. Opponents must be a minimum of 5 yards away from the ball until it is played in.
- A goal cannot be scored directly from a kick off, it must be touched by a teammate or another player.
- ***There are no Direct Free Kicks or Penalty Kicks for U6-U8. All free kicks are indirect.**

Before you begin the game-Remind everybody with a nice loud voice;

1. No Jewelry
2. No foul language-5 minute penalty and (possible red card-Referee's discretion)
3. No Slide Tackles-2 minute penalty and (possible yellow card-Referee's discretion)
4. Every kick is an indirect free kick except for a penalty kick
