



## STEPS TO FOLLOW IF YOU ARE TO BECOME A NEW REFEREE IN 2019

1. To become a referee with the Pickering Soccer Club you must:
  - a. Be 12 years of age as of March 31, 2019 for Small Sided Games and 14 years of age as of March 31, 2019 for the Entry Level Clinic.
  - b. Attend an Entry Level Clinic or attend a Small Sided Game Clinic – hosted by clubs in Ontario Soccer – and successfully pass the Laws of the Game Test that is part of both Clinics.
  - c. The Pickering Soccer Club will be hosting two Small Sided Game Clinic in 2019:
    - April 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> – class room 5 pm to 9 pm on April 2 – On Field 7 pm to 9 pm on April 3<sup>rd</sup> Pickering Soccer Centre - \$95 Fee
    - April 13 – 9 am to 3 pm at the Pickering Soccer Centre - \$95 Fee
    - At the moment both of these Clinics are private/closed but if space is available will become open registration on March 18
  - d. The Pickering Soccer Club will be hosting an Entry Level Clinic (Full field Games) in 2018.
    - April 27 and 28 (8:30 am to 5:30 pm)– Pickering Soccer Centre - \$130 Fee
2. If you are interested in attending either or both of these clinics please go to [www.refcentre.com/ontario](http://www.refcentre.com/ontario) to register.
3. If you are attending a PSC Clinic pay the registration fee at the PSC office (Pickering Soccer Club – 1975 Clements Road) by March 25 for Small Sided Clinics and April 19 for Entry Level .
4. The clinics include in class instruction and field instruction.
5. The maximum number of students for each clinic is 25. **PLEASE NOTE THAT REGISTRATION IS NOT COMPLETE UNTIL PAYMENT IS MADE IN FULL.**
6. Once the registration fee has been received by the Pickering Soccer Club you will be made active in Ref Centre. The PSC will send you an email to advise you of this and you will then be able to begin the online preparation work for the clinic. The online preparation work must be completed prior to attending the clinic.
7. Attend the clinic – be at the clinic no less than 20 minutes before the start time and be dressed for physical activity. Bring a pen and paper and the required documents from your prep work.
8. Complete the online exam by the deadline date assigned by the clinic instructor.
9. After successful completion of the course, including a passing mark on the exam, you will be registered as an Ontario Soccer official. You will also be registered as a referee with the Pickering Soccer Club.
10. Attend the PSC Referees Meeting in May – date/time TBA. At this meeting you will be informed on the Pickering Soccer Club Referee Program.
11. Referee’s Kit can be purchased from our on line store with Soccer Xpress. Information on items in the kit, and how to order will be provided at the clinics.
