Job Description

The All Abilities soccer program offers children and youth with intellectual and/or physical disabilities, an opportunity to learn and play soccer.

Every child deserves a chance to build lasting friendships, make memories and feel like they belong. The All Abilities team strives for an inclusive environment where no child is noticed for their disability. It is a place where enormous abilities shine.

Our program is fully inclusive, designed and adapted for children with any disability or level of behaviour. Whether they use a wheelchair, walker or wear orthotics, or live with an intellectual, communication (ASD) or developmental disability, we provide support (1:1 as needed) and welcome all on the field.

The Pickering Soccer Club's All Abilities Program is at the forefront of development of not only soccer programs but also physical literacy programming, and recreation/socialization opportunities.

Supporting weekly All Abilities Sessions & Outreach Programs

- Attend and assist with the weekly AA practices for both U12 and U18
- Attend orientation and other training as required
- Participate in planning and setting-up practices, setting-up, taking down, and storing equipment, matching and assigning volunteers, leading practice sessions, providing on-field support & instruction
- Evaluating sessions and planning new sessions
- Performing administrative duties including attending/participating in Team meetings, completing reports, equipment inventory, etc.
- Developing new tools to enhance communication with parents

Supporting program marketing, promotions and special events

- Implementing an existing, or designing a new, special event
- Developing and distributing outreach materials
- Preparing marketing and sponsorship materials
- Conducting other general program duties as assigned that support the operations and delivery of the AA Program as assigned

Requirements

- Must be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment
- Must have been registered as full-time students in the previous academic year and intend to return to school on a full-time basis in the next academic year
- Must be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act Footnote 2 for the duration of the employment
- Must have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial or territorial legislation and regulations
- Criminal/Vulnerable Sector Check
- Must be returning to school in September
- First Aid & CPR strongly recommended
- All candidates must be available to start on May 6
- All candidates must be available Wednesday evenings, May – August.
